## ACOLYTE TRAINING TODAY

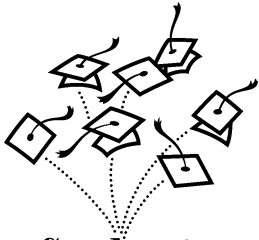

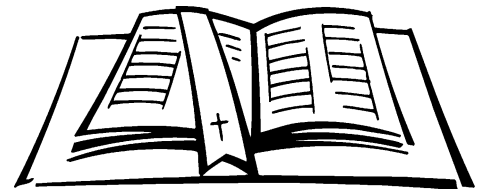

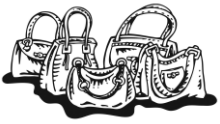
## MEN'S FELLOWSHIP (M.C.S.F.)
