Re-Vision 2021

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In July of 2019, a diverse group of people, representative of the entire congregation, participated in a survey through Natural Church Development. The survey focused on eight quality characteristics: Empowering Leadership (in general, not Pastor or Board related), Gift-Based Ministry, Passionate Spirituality, Effective Structures, Inspiring Worship, Holistic Small Groups, Need-Oriented Evangelism and Loving Relationships.

Our results were predominantly favorable, indicating The Church at Litchfield Park was overall quite healthy. However, the scores did indicate there were a couple of areas that needed attention, including developing a clear vision.

Developing a clear vision is the first step in addressing the other areas requiring attention. Therefore, in October 2019, the Board of Directors and congregation commissioned a group of people, representative of the entire congregation, to serve on a Re-Vision Team led by a coach who specializes in church vitality.

The Re-Vision Team (Kristin McNamara, Eric Jameson, Marcy Clement, Ken Martin, Jill Tabata, Cedric Nixon, Mari Riggins, Al Peterson, Carrie Bemis, Joe Broski, Jennifer Scott, Dick Vasiloff and Pastor Lynne) spent several weekends with its coach, which included several homework assignments and extra meetings between the coaching sessions.

Our team interviewed people in the community, reviewed demographic data, wrote a new mission statement, identified and wrote core value statements, formed a prayer team, and spent countless hours in prayer. Every single ministry at The Church at Litchfield Park was reviewed to determine how they aligned with our mission statement and which core value was being addressed.

This was a very emotional process, involving hard and painful conversations, and a lot of prayer. As we looked at each thing we do through the lens of our new vision and core values, some things were perfectly aligned, others needed some tweaking and new goals to line up, still others did not have a way forward.

It is hard letting go of things we have done for a long time and to embrace a new journey. Our coach reminded us, on more than one occasion, that just because something is good does not mean it should continue, especially if it does not move forward on a specific core value.

The work we engaged in led to the formation of twelve Ministry Teams – Administration, Adult Ministry, Children's Ministry, Community Engagement, Fellowship, First Impressions, Missions, Prayer, Support, Technology, Worship, and Youth Ministry.

In March of 2020, just before the COVID pause, others from the congregation were invited to participate in a meeting with our coach. Based on previous experience and areas of interest, each participant was invited to sit at one team's table to help establish goals for that particular area of ministry and develop a timeline for accomplishing those goals.

The next step was for each team to get together to begin the writing of actions plans that were specific, measurable, attainable, relevant, and time bound. The pandemic hindered our work, slowing down our progress. None of us ever expected a delay, especially one this long, when we first started the process.

Thank you for your prayers, support, and patience. In the attached report you will find our Statement of Faith, Mission Statement, Vision Statement, Core Values, a comprehensive list of one year goals for each Ministry Team, and a list of future goals. We pray that everyone will find a way to get involved by investing their time, talent, and treasure.
